12-14 April 2024 'Bridge on the River (K)Wye'*

Friday 12 April 2024

You can check in to the Palace Hotel, Buxton (SK17 6AG) from 16:00. The hotel has your IRL names and your hash names. Parking is free in the hotel car park but you must register your car at reception.

But you can arrive earlier to enjoy lovely Buxton. Don't forget to collect your goody bag from Ratty or Physy.

Here are some suggestions to visit Friday afternoon on:

- The Buxton Pavilion hosts a cafe, art gallery and shop, and Buxton Brewery micro-tap
- The Pavilion Gardens for a walk
- Buxton Crescent and sample the spa waters at St. Ann's Well
- A bit out of town, the limestone rock formations at Poole's Cavern and Solomon's Temple folly
- The Ale Stop, Seasons micropub or RedWillow brewery tap for some refreshments
- Beer and Bean cafe bar right opposite the hotel.

We have booked the Cellar Bar at the Buxton Brewery Tap House as a meeting point from 6pm onwards.

- Food is available (menu tbc).

Saturday 13 April 2024

The hash circle will meet at 10:30, outside the hotel entrance (unless raining).

The run:

IMPORTANT:

- **The run does not start from the hotel.**
- We will be catching a public bus to the start location.
 - The bus stop is opposite Buxton Railway station (2 min walk from the Hotel)
 - **We will be catching BUS #65 at 11:00.**
 - It's possible to drive, but parking is limited at the destination pub. If you choose to drive, please offer spare seats to other hashers.
- **WALKERS** will be doing an A to B trail. You need to get off the bus with Ratty and Miss Pilsbury when instructed.

- **RUNNERS** will be doing a circular trail from the Anglers Rest pub in Millers Dale. You need to get off the bus with Physy Blonde and Nelson (and all remaining hashers) when instructed.
Note: the main trail is quite strenuous. If you are not running, it is **strongly** advised that you follow the walkers trail.
- **APRES** will be at the Anglers Rest pub in Millers Dale. This is the end of the trail for walkers and runners.
 - We have the snug bar reserved, and there will be snacks provided.
